

**FERRAZZI:
DO NOT GET CONFUSED BETWEEN
WINE AND DRUNKER**

Do not criminalize wine. Luca Ferrazzi, regional assessor for agriculture, takes position about discussion that is taking place these days in the Commission of Transports at the Lower House and, highlighting the importance of road safety, repeats the "no" to zero tolerance talking about alcohol. «Reset the percentage limit of alcohol level in blood for those people who drive – says- or bring the value to a level where even a glass of wine is not allowed, is not the right answer to increase the road safety. It would be a precaution that risks striking again with big economical problems on a pillar of the made in Italy as the oe-gastronomic sector. Solutions are other, starting from the increment of controls and certainty of punishment to whoever drives after having drunk or under the effect of drugs».

Ferrazzi's opinion is not isolated and it is actually close to the ones coming from other representatives of the Italian regions, who are all seriously worried for the possible repercussions that could occur in the wine factory in case of "criminalization" of the bottle. These repercussions could completely hit the sector of restoration.
